#### UPDATE ON THE STATE OF EMERGENCY – COVID 19 LOCKDOWN SITUATION

The whole world has been affected with the coronavirus pandemic. It has been a difficult few week for all of us thus far. The extraordinary measures that have been taken have disrupted our lives. However, it is imperative to stay focused. It is our aim to be pro-active in every way possible. I thank you for your cooperation and assistance throughout the past weeks since the declaration of the State of Emergency on 17 March 2020.

On 30 April 2020, His excellency the President of Namibia, Dr. Hage Geingob further declared the following: "The incidence curve of the pandemic flattened at 16 cases, with 8 recoveries. There have been no community transmissions to this end and zero deaths recorded in Namibia so far. The countrywide lockdown will lapse at midnight on Monday the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 2020 for a period of 28 days. There is therefore merit to relax some of the restrictions. Stage 2 will be a gradual re-opening under Strict Precautions, from Tuesday 5 May 2020 until the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June 2020".

- "During Stage 2 the following measures will apply to all Namibians:
- \*All members of the public are required to wear facemasks in public spaces.
- \*People will be permitted to travel domestically between regions and within towns and cities, without restriction.
- \*Our borders will remain closed for non-Namibians but returning Namibians will be permitted to re-enter the country, subject to screening at points of entry and supervised quarantine for 14 days.
- \*Businesses and productive activities will be permitted to reopen, subject to responsible personal and organizational conduct and in compliance with the prescribed Health & Hygiene Guidelines.
- \*Stage 3 and Stage 4 in terms of timelines are indicative and intended to assist with business planning. The actual duration of each stage may be reduced or extended, subject to monitoring reports and the changing situation in the country".

#### ARRANGEMENTS AT WALVIS BAY PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL

**\$ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES**: Taking above into consideration, our Administrative offices will reopen from Tuesday 5 May 2020 and our caretaker and his team will continue ensuring that our facility is in compliance with the prescribed Health & Hygiene Guidelines, cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces.

**GRADE 11AS LANE AND GRADE 12 LEARNERS:** Due to the unfortunate event of the Lockdown in the country we could not complete the Internal Examination, which was first scheduled for 16 March 2020, then deferred to 20 April 2020. Adhering to the 10 people in a venue rule, it has been decided to complete the long overdue examination for the Grade 11AS lane and Grade 12 learners only, as from 7 May 2020. We will not make use of the Tom Swemmer Hall, usually allocated for their examinations, but make use of classrooms and ensure that there are not more than 10 people in each venue. Learners will report for their exam according to the timetable included in this Newsletter, continue social distancing protocols of at least 1.5 meters between persons and return home immediately after they have completed their exam papers. A face-mask will be handed to them as they enter the school and sanitizers will be available at the entrance, in each classroom and in the ablution facilities. They must use the same exam table for the duration of the exam.

**\$GRADE 1 TO GRADE 11 ORDINARY LANE E-LEARNING:** The staff of Walvis Bay Private High School will continue providing alternative teaching and learning for Grades 1 to Grade 11 Ordinary lane learners.

**SMEETING WITH MINISTRY OF EDUCATION - HEAD OFFICE**: As advised by our Regional Director Mrs. Stephanus, along with other Principals of Private Schools following the Namibian Cambridge Curriculum, I will attend an urgent meeting with the Executive Director of Education Mrs. Sanet Steenkamp and the Deputy Executive Director of Education Mrs. Eda Bohn, within the next week to request written consent or guidance for the relaxation for stage 2 so that learners may return to school earlier.

We depend on your constant support of your child and assistance to the staff of the school in the academic approach as has been the case thus far. Thank you for ensuring that the basic devices are available for your child to access the e-learning options we are providing.

Please adhere to the guidelines as set out by the World Health Organisation. Immune boosters, flu vaccines, etc. are especially important measures that have been advised to be used. Anyone with symptoms of a dry cough, high fever and shortness of breath should stay at home and consult a health practitioner or community health worker.

To conclude I believe that our Heavenly Father will guide and protect us in this difficult time and continue to give us hope for the future.
